A Message from the Rector

Theme Song: "Days of Elijah"
Scripture: Genesis 41: 15-16

Being thrown into a big hole in the ground and left to die is not the way I would choose for God to awaken me to my dream! But that's just what Joseph's loving (and somewhat jealous) brothers did in response to Joseph's youthful pride and arrogance (boys will be boys).

Joseph, with God's help, learned that events and "circumstances" in one's life do not matter as much as how we respond when things happen. Joseph went on to discover that he (little "h") was not the one interpreting dreams. Pharaoh said to Joseph, "I had a dream, and no one can interpret it. But I have heard it said of you that when you hear a dream you can interpret it." "I cannot do it," Joseph replied to Pharaoh, "but God will give Pharaoh the answer he desires." (Genesis 41:15-16)
